The capital campaign, approved by the Bethel Home Governing Board and the Bethel Foundation Board, is nearly completed. The campaign has collected over \$618,000 in cash and pledges.

Construction of the new beauty/barber shop, craft room and social areas has begun, and the renovation work within the Bethel Community will begin soon. Renovation includes a new fire sprinkler system, floor coverings, lighting, bathroom ventilation, heating and cooling systems, and a new communications and medical records system. We hope that the expansion and renovation work within the Bethel Community will be completed in March when Bethel celebrates its 50th anniversary.

A full listing of all participants and donors of the campaign will be published in April. Special recognition will be given to individuals, families, congregations, and businesses who contributed gifts of \$5,000 or more to the *Caring-Preparing* Capital Campaign.
